Commitment, Fee, and Refund Policy

Commitment & Tryouts

For the 14's and 16's levels, the official start of the season begins at the start of the tryouts and player selection. The fees must be paid before the athlete is allowed to begin tryouts, and fees will not be refunded once the tryouts and player selection begin.

For the 12's division, the first day of practice constitutes the start of the season.

Once tryouts are complete and teams are posted, if an athlete decides to withdraw, no refunds will be given.

In the unfortunate event of withdraws, the Hutch JO Board reserves the right to adjust the remaining players onto teams based on skill testing results. No refunds will be given in this circumstance.

Fees

All fees must be paid on time according to the schedule set by the JO Board. If a registration fee payment is returned for NSF, all fees associated with the NSF will need to be paid by the offending party.

Consequences of no payment, late payment, or returned checks:

1. Players will not be able to tryout until payment is made
2. Players will not be able to practice until payment is made.
3. Players will not be able to play in competition until payment is made

Fee Refund:

1. If an injury occurs during the tryouts and player selection, the athlete may decide to withdraw and receive a full refund upon presentation of a doctor's note.
2. Should participant become injured after tryouts and player selection, a prorated refund will be issued upon presentation of a doctor's note.
3. A participant that is cut from the team will be given a full refund. Should a participant quit no refund will be issued.

Quitting Policy

1. If a player quit during the previous season, and it was **not** for a medical reason, the player will be required to pay fees for the past season and the current season in advance.
2. If a player encounters a medical condition or a season-ending injury, there will be a prorated (by day) refund of fees paid and no penalty will apply for the following year.

3. If a player quits for any reason other than a medical condition, the player is liable for the full season fee, and/or no refund will be issued.

4. If a player has quit, but feels there are extenuating circumstances associated with their decision, and they want the requirement for prepayment waived, the player and parent must appear in person before the Board to present their case.

Elite Team: Player Commitment

Player is responsible for the entire season dues, even if the player chooses not to participate once she signs her letter of commitment.

If there is an injury during the season that continued participation is not possible for the remainder of the season, a doctor's note is required. An attempt will be made to find a replacement for the participant. Any replacement must be approved by the board. The replacement participant would then be responsible for the financial costs for the remainder of the season. If a suitable replacement cannot be found, the injured participant and her family are responsible for all unavoidable expenses for the remainder of the season.

Elite Team

1. For those athletes wishing to try out for the Elite, mixed age group, team, the regular JO registration fee is due by the registration deadline. The official start of the season begins at the start of the placement test.

2. At the time an athlete is placed on the Elite team, a contract stating they are committing to the season shall be signed. An additional payment will also be required per the contract. If full payment for the season is not made, a payment plan contract will be required.

3. If an athlete is not selected for the Elite team, she may opt to join the regular JO program at her age level (or higher if approved by the JO Board), or receive full refund of fees paid.

4. If payments are not made by the due dates outlined on the payment contract, the athlete will not be allowed to participate in either practices or matches until brought up to date. If 2 payments are delinquent, full payment of the remaining balance will be necessary for the player to be allowed to participate.

5. If an athlete defaults on the payment plan or quits the team, she will not be eligible for future participation in the Elite team.
